Need dependable and inexpensive transportation to get around Quincy? Then the Quincy Shuttle is your answer.

The Quincy Shuttle is a public transportation service that **operates Monday through Friday from 7:30 am to 2:30 pm for just \$1 per trip**. A 20-Ride pass is \$18; a 40-Ride pass is \$35. These passes are also usable on the *Gadsden Express* and *Gadsden Connector*.

The Shuttle makes stops at several locations throughout Quincy. See the inside of this brochure for route and schedule details. Small route deviations of up to 3/4 mile are available but you must contact Big Bend Transit at 627-9958 at least 24 hours in advance to schedule these stops or pick ups.

Shuttle riders can also connect with both the Gadsden Express and Gadsden Connector. The Gadsden Express provides weekday service to Tallahassee. The Gadsden Connector travels between Havana and Chattahoochee with stops in Quincy, Greensboro, and Gretna.



SCHEDULE

The Quincy Shuttle operates Monday through Friday from 7:30 am to 2:30 pm. The Shuttle serves stops at the same time after each hour.

To determine when the bus arrives at a stop, locate your stop # on the map and find that # on this schedule.

Each tick mark represents one minute. For example, the Shuttle arrives at Stop #19 at 15 minutes after each hour; it loads and unloads at Stop #1 at 30 minutes after the hour.

REMEMBER, the Shuttle ends service at 2:30 pm. Please plan accordingly.
