Need transportation to Tallahassee? The Gadsden Connector connects with the Gadsden Express at the Winn Dixie in Quincy. The Express operates to and from Tallahassee Monday through Saturday from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm. The weekday fare is \$1/trip; the Saturday fare is \$3/trip.

The Gadsden Connector also connects with the Quincy Shuttle at the Winn Dixie in Quincy. The Shuttle operates M-F from 7:30 am to 2:30 pm. The fare is \$1.





Go from car-free to carefree with Commuter Services of North Florida's **Emergency Ride Home Program**. If you travel to **work** by bus, carpool, vanpool, or bike at least 3 days per week, this program provides you with a free cab ride in the event that an emergency arises.



The **Gadsden Connector** is a deviated fixed-route public transportation service that operates Monday through Friday and provides service between Chattahoochee and Havana with stops in Greensboro, Gretna, and Quincy. The service begins at 7:00 am and ends at 2:55 pm. **The cost is \$1 per trip.** Discounted 20-Ride and 40-Ride passes are available.

In Quincy, riders can connect with both the *Quincy Shuttle* and *Gadsden Express*, giving residents access to points throughout the region. The *Quincy Shuttle* and *Gadsden Express* require an additional fare. See map and schedule for details.

Although these routes are designed to provide as many connections as possible, service is limited. Check times carefully when planning your trip.


3/4 mile deviations are allowable along the route, but you must contact Big Bend Transit (850) 627-9958 at least 24 hours in advance to request and schedule such stops.

Gadsden Connector riders can transfer to the Gadsden Express at Stop #5. Riders can transfer to the Quincy Shuttle at Stops #5 and #6.

Additional fares apply when transferring, but you can use multi-ride passes on all three services.
